We're giving out **\$2,000 scholarships to 20 students**. Want your students to win? Give them plenty of opportunities to learn about the competition.

Here's a handy checklist of ways to spread the word:



- ☐ Post about the competition on your school's social media pages. Visit **LMCU.org/Hutt** for ready-to-share posts and videos.
- ☐ Put up the scholarship poster in a high-traffic area. Posters can be found on our school resources page at **LMCU.org/Hutt**.
- ☐ If appropriate, assign this year's essay prompt as a class project.
- ☐ Encourage other school staff to spread the word: for example, English teachers, coaches, counselors and other faculty who work with seniors.
- ☐ Email parents of seniors and encourage them to visit **LMCU.org/Hutt** for more info.
- ☐ Post competition info on your school's website.
- ☐ Invite an LMCU representative to staff a table during lunchtime or speak to a senior class during class or an assembly.
- ☐ Include info in your school's newsletter. **Here's an example** you could use for newsletter content:
Lake Michigan Credit Union (LMCU) is now accepting applications for the 2025–2026 Hutt Scholarship! High school seniors can enter to win one of 20 \$2,000 scholarships. To enter, applicants are tasked with writing an essay on the topic, "How do you stay authentic to yourself and your values in today's fast-paced world, where so much takes place online?" The deadline for entry is December 15, 2025. Interested seniors can learn more and submit their applications at LMCU.org/Hutt.

The deadline to enter this year's scholarship competition is 12/15/2025.

Who's eligible to enter?

Any high school senior who plans on enrolling in college, a university, a trade school, or other form of higher education in the next academic school year can enter the Hutt Scholarship competition. Applicants must be residents of Michigan or Florida, or a member of Lake Michigan Credit Union, or the child of a member (for example, a student in Texas must be an LMCU member or the child of a member).
